



 Γ he students are the pivotal point of a University system. 



They were asked to provide their opinion on the following points pertaining to their overall experience in connection with the University:


- Impact of your educational background for benefiting from the program?

- Was the internal assessment system helpful in understanding the course?


- Was the internal assessment system conducive to early discovery of difficulties?

- After leaving the University how would they talk about it?






































































































Overall Rating of the Program


























The overall assessment is encouraging. However, there is scope of further improvement and we shall work towards it.
