Sigamani also said that LIC's proposed online portal Bima Sugam, which will facilitate all insurance related ac-

tivities online, would ruin all the company's agents, who are dependent on it for livelihood.

"Once this Bima Sugam portal comes to act, policy holders will face huge problem as agents will not be available to serve them as it will be done online. Livelihood of agents will be erased. Already unemployment rate is increasing day-by-day. So, this new scheme will not bring any good to policy holders, but will put LIC on closure," he said.

He also urged the government to stop the proposed Bima Sugam portal.

अगरतला, 27 दिसंबर। त्रिपुरा विश्वविद्यालय ने शिक्षा मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार से ग्राम निर्देशों के अनुसार 26 दिसंबर को 'वीर बाल दिवस' के रूप में मनाया, भारत के 'आजादी का अमृत महोत्सव' के तहत। इस सिलसिले में विश्वविद्यालय ने 'सिख गुरुओं' के बलिदान को याद करने के लिए एक प्रतिष्ठित व्याख्यान का आयोजन किया। डॉ. जसपाल सिंह, सदस्य, राष्ट्रीय अल्पसंख्यक शैक्षिक संस्थान आयोग और पूर्व कुलपति, पंजाबी विश्वविद्यालय, पटियाला और मोजाय्बिक और स्वाजीलैंड के पूर्व भारतीय राजदूत ने अपना मुख्य भाषण दिया। डॉ. सिंह ने साहिबजादा जोरावत सिंह जी और साहिबजादा फतेह सिंह जी की 'शहादत' को विस्तार से बताया, जिन्हें क्रमशः मात्र 9 और 7 वर्ष की अल्पयु में देश के लिए शहीद होना पड़ा।

आश्वासन दिया कि, इन सभी ऐतिहासिक तथ्यों को छद्म-2020 के तहत कवर किया जाएगा। गौरतलब है कि कार्यक्रम की शुरुआत सिख धर्म के सभी मर्यादाओं और रीति-रिवाजों का पालन करते हुए की गई, कार्यक्रम की शुरुआत शब्द- 'देह शिव बर मोहै एह शुभ कर्मों ते कबहू न तरुण...' के पाठ से हुई। विश्वविद्यालय में पहली बार स्थानीय प्रतिभागियों, कर्मचारियों और छात्रों को सिख संस्कृति और रीति-रिवाजों के बारे में पता चला। कार्यक्रम हाइब्रिड मोड में आयोजित किया गया और दो सौ से अधिक प्रतिभागियों ने लाभ उठाया। मुख्य चक्रा डॉ. परम चकमा, सहायक द्वारा पेश किया गया था। प्रोफेसर, समाजशास्त्र विभाग और इसे डॉ. मुनीन्द्र मिगा, सहायक द्वारा संचालित किया गया था, निदेशक (राजभाषा), त्रिपुरा विश्वविद्यालय ने कहा।

असम आंदोलन के 'वंचित' घायल व्यक्तियों ने सरकार से की कार्रवाई की मांग

गुवाहाटी, 27 दिसंबर, (सैयद मोजाम्मिल हक)। लखीमपुर जिले में गण संग्राम परिषद (जीएसपी) और ऑल असम स्टूडेंट्स युनियन (आसू) के पूर्व नेताओं के एक वर्ग ने असम सरकार से असम आंदोलन (1979 - 1985) के 'गंभीर रूप से घायल व्यक्तियों' के एक वर्ग के खिलाफ कार्रवाई करने की मांग की है, जिन्हें 'फर्जी' प्रमाण पत्र जमा करके सरकार से 2,00,000 रुपये की एकमुश्त अनुग्रह राशि मिली थी। इन नेताओं ने सरकार से असम आंदोलन के 'गंभीर रूप से घायल वास्तविक व्यक्तियों' को न्याय देने की भी मांग की है, जिन्हें उचित मान्यता और असम सरकार द्वारा प्रायोजित अनुग्रह राशि से वंचित कर दिया गया है। उल्लेखनीय है कि असम सरकार ने गुवाहाटी के पश्चिम बोरानागिब स्थित स्वाहिद स्मारक पार्क में आयोजित एक औपचारिक कार्यक्रम में 10 दिसंबर को स्वाहिद दिवस के अवसर पर असम आंदोलन (1979 - 1985) के कुल 192 गंभीर रूप से घायल व्यक्तियों में से प्रत्येक को एकमुश्त अनुग्रह राशि का भुगतान किया। उनमें से लखीमपुर जिले के कुल 37 लोगों को भी उस दिन अनुग्रह राशि का भुगतान मिला था। जीएसपी और आसू के पूर्व नेताओं ने आरोप लगाया कि 37 में से एक वर्ग गंभीर रूप से घायल व्यक्ति का फर्जी प्रमाण पत्र जमा करके गंभीर रूप से घायल व्यक्ति का फर्जी प्रमाण पत्र जमा करके अनुग्रह राशि प्राप्त करने में कामयाब रहा। इस मुद्दे पर चर्चा के लिए जीएसपी और आसू के इन पूर्व नेताओं ने रविवार को उत्तरी लखीमपुर शहर में स्थित असम गण परिषद के लखीमपुर जिला कार्यालय गण भवन में एक बैठक का आयोजन किया। बैठक की अध्यक्षता आसू की लखीमपुर जिला (अविभाजित) इकाई के पूर्व अध्यक्ष रुद्र गोर्गाई ने की। बैठक के उद्देश्य को समझते हुए, पूर्व आसू और जीएसपी नेता देउती दास ने

कहा कि व्यक्तियों का एक वर्ग असम आंदोलन में घायल हुए बिना, फर्जी प्रमाण पत्र प्रस्तुत करके असम सरकार से मान्यता और अनुग्रह राशि का भुगतान प्राप्त करने में कामयाब रहा था। बैठक के दौरान लखीमपुर के पूर्व विधायक सह आसू नेता उपयल दत्ता, आसू के पूर्व नेता बिनोद गोर्गाई, प्रदीप निबार्ग, धनमोनी हजारीका, देबा प्रसाद सैकिया, कुला दत्ता, प्रशांत नाथ ने इस मुद्दे पर चर्चा में हिस्सा लिया। चर्चा के बाद लिए गए प्रस्ताव के अनुसार, बैठक में असम सरकार को 'असम आंदोलन के गंभीर रूप से घायल लोगों' की शारा के खिलाफ कार्रवाई करने के लिए एक महीने की समय सीमा तय की गई। बैठक में सरकार से असम आंदोलन के दौरान गंभीर रूप से घायल



हूए वास्तविक लोगों की सूची बनाने और अनुग्रह राशि के भुगतान के साथ उन्हें उचित मान्यता देने के लिए एक साधन तैयार करने की भी मांग की गई। इस संबंध में, बैठक में आसू के मीजुदा निकाय से इस मामले में अपनी जांच शुरू करने और संगठन को गुप्त रहने वाले फर्जी गंभीर रूप से घायल व्यक्तियों की पहचान करने का आह्वान किया गया। बैठक में निर्णय लिया गया कि यदि सरकार ने उनके खिलाफ कोई कार्रवाई नहीं की तो गंभीर रूप से घायल फर्जी व्यक्तियों के उपरोक्त वर्ग के खिलाफ कानूनी कार्रवाई शुरू की जाएगी। एक अन्य प्रस्ताव लेकर बैठक में एक संयोजक समिति का गठन किया गया, जिसमें देउती दास, बिनोद गोर्गाई, धनमोनी हजारीका मुख्य संयोजक, चकील तीर्थ दास कानूनी प्रकोष्ठ के संयोजक होंगे, ताकि असम आंदोलन के वंचित, वास्तविक गंभीर रूप से घायल व्यक्तियों को एकजुट करने की पहल की जा सके।

असम के सीएम ने गिरजाघरों के गिनती मामले से खुद को अलग किया, जांच करने को कहा



गुवाहाटी, 27 दिसंबर, (सैयद मोजाम्मिल हक)। असम के मुख्यमंत्री हिमंत बिस्वा सरमा ने राज्य पुलिस के उस निदेश से दूरी बना ली है, जिसमें जिलों की गिरजाघरों का सर्वेक्षण करने के लिए कहा गया था। उन्होंने पुलिस महानिदेशक (डीजीपी) को इस तरह का पत्र जारी करने के कारणों की जांच करने और तुरंत सुधारात्मक उपाय करने को कहा है। मुख्यमंत्री ने कहा, गिरजाघर जैसे धार्मिक संस्थानों का सर्वेक्षण करने की असम सरकार की कोई मंता नहीं है। मुख्यमंत्री असम पुलिस की विशेष शाखा द्वारा जिला प्रशासन को लिखे गए उस पत्र पर प्रतिक्रिया दे रहे थे, जिसमें गिरजाघरों की संख्या, धर्मोत्तरण और जब्त धर्मोत्तरण में शामिल लोगों (यदि कोई हो तो) उनके बारे में जानकारी मांगी गई थी। मुख्यमंत्री ने कहा, मुझे लगता है कि हमें इस तरह की जानकारी नहीं मांगनी चाहिए कि असम में कितने गिरजाघर हैं। इससे किसी विशेष धार्मिक समुदाय की भावना आहत हो सकती है। हमें इस तरह की चीजों से दूर रहना चाहिए। उन्होंने कहा, मैं इस पत्र से पूरी तरह से किनारा करता हूँ क्योंकि किसी भी सरकारी मंच पर इस बारे में कभी चर्चा नहीं हुई। पत्र पूरी तरह से अनुचित है और असम के नागरिक के रूप में, हम सभी समुदायों के साथ शांति और सद्भाव से रहना चाहते हैं। उन्होंने कहा, मैंने डीजीपी को जांच करने और सुधारात्मक उपाय करने को कहा है क्योंकि सरकार किसी भी समुदाय की धार्मिक भावनाओं को ठेस नहीं पहुंचाना चाहती है।

त्रिपुरा में विस चुनाव से पहले माकपा और कांग्रेस साथ आरपी

अगरतला, 27 दिसम्बर (बार्ता)। त्रिपुरा में भारतीय जनता पार्टी (भाजपा) के नेतृत्व वाली सरकार के खिलाफ गैर भाजपा दलों ने मंगलवार को एक संयुक्त बयान जारी कर लोगों से कथित कुशासन के खिलाफ एकजुट होने का आह्वान किया गया। मार्क्सवादी कम्युनिस्ट पार्टी (माकपा) नीत वाममोर्चा और कांग्रेस की बहुचर्चित चुनावी गठजोड़ बनाने के प्रयासों के बीच इन दलों ने यहां एक संयुक्त बयान में उल्लेख किया गया है कि माकपा और कांग्रेस की पहल लोकतंत्र की बहाली, कानून के शासन की बहाली और स्वतंत्र और निष्पक्ष चुनाव कराने के लिए की गई है, जिसे टीआईपीआर मोथा सुप्रीमो और शाही चंडा प्रद्योत किशोर देवबर्मन ने भी समर्थन दिया है। माकपा के प्रदेश सचिव जितेंद्र चौधरी ने कहा, टिआ मोथा के अध्यक्ष से भी मुझे पर सहाय ली गई है और उन्होंने व्यापक रूप से कांग्रेस और सीपी (आईएम) के विचारों का समर्थन किया है। यह अभी अगरतला में उपलब्ध नहीं है। उन्होंने कहा कि संयुक्त बयान भाजपा को हराने के लिए त्रिपुरा में विधानसभा चुनाव से पहले सभी धर्मनिरपेक्ष और लोकतांत्रिक ताकतों को एकजुट करने की पहल का हिस्सा है। हालांकि इस कदम में पार्टियों की संयुक्त प्रतिक्रिया के रूप में देखा गया है, भी चौधरी ने कहा कि पहल का उद्देश्य भाजपा दल राज्य में सामान्य स्थिति बहाल करने के लिए है। उन्होंने कहा है, जहां पिछले 58 महीनों के भाजपा शासन में लोकतांत्रिक प्रक्रियाएं घोंटा गया है। इस बयान पर कांग्रेस के प्रदेश अध्यक्ष बिरजीत सिन्हा, माकपा के सचिव जितेंद्र चौधरी और सीपीआई, आरएसपी, फॉरवर्ड ब्लॉक और सीपीआई (एमएल)

sacrifice of 'Sikh Gurus', sources informed. Dr. Jaspal Singh, Member, National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions and former Vice-Chancellor, Punjabi University, Patiala and also former Indian Ambassador to Mozambique and Swaziland, delivered his keynote speech.
