SOPs issued for Hostellers in accordance with the directions laid down in Clause No. 4.2.3 of the UGC Guidelines for *Re-opening the Universities and Colleges Post Lockdown due to COVID-19 Pandemic* dated 5<sup>th</sup> November 2020

- 1. Symptomatic students shall not be allowed under any circumstances.
- 2. Students seeking entry into P.G. Gents & P.G. Girls Hostels need to produce Double Vaccination Certificate / COVID-19 test negative (RT PCR) Report (within 72 hrs.).
- 3. Thermal screening before entry in each Hostel shall be carried out.
- 4. Hostelers should compulsorily use Face masks and sanitiser of their own.
- 5. There should be no crowding in hostel areas where students live in close proximity and share common facilities and utilities.
- 6. In case of necessity, they will be referred to the nearest COVID treatment facility for clinical assessment and treatment.
- 7. Density in dining halls, common rooms, playing areas should be limited, keeping in view the requirement of physical distancing.
- 8. Hygiene conditions should be regularly monitored in kitchens, dining halls, bathrooms and toilets etc.
- 9. Cleanliness is to be maintained in dining areas. Meals should be served in small batches, avoiding over-crowding. Take away options should be available for students and staff.
- 10. It must be ensured that the meals are freshly cooked. A senior staff should monitor the same.
- 11. Utensils should be properly cleaned.
- 12. Wearing of face cover/ masks and proper sanitization of hands of the staff engaged for the preparation and distribution of meals should be ensured.
- 13. Resident students and staff should avoid or limit visiting the markets.
- 14. Hostels wardens may define the number of students in dining halls at any point in time. Mess timings may be increased to avoid overcrowding.
- 15. Any symptomatic student should be sent to the TU Health Centre for further check-up.

The above-mentioned students may be allowed to enter the hostel premises from 15.12.2021.
