The validity of this approval order is subjected to fulfilling the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The amount allocated for each course is the maximum amount and is to be spent for (a) honorarium and travel of one foreign expert/faculty only (b) lecture note preparation (c) video recording of the course (d) contingencies and miscellaneous expenses, if any. A maximum of Rs. 1.5 lakhs (for one week course, 10-14 lectures) and Rs. 2 lakhs for (2 weeks course, 20-28 lectures) can be spent for items (b), (c) and (d) only.
- The activities in the scheme should be limited to the extents of fund available with the grantee Institution at any given time. The grantee Institution would bear responsibility for any expenditure incurred over and above available grants and the sanctioning authority or MHRD would not be liable to reimburse the same, on a routine basis, except as per rules.
- 3. A statement of expenditure and utilization certificate of the fund released signed by the appropriate financial authority should be sent within 30 days after completion of the course. The GIAN implementation Committee will be liberty to blacklist those Institutions, which do not submit the utilization certificate within the prescribed time from any future participation in the GIAN initiative and recommend to MHRD for stringent action.
- 4. Each course should be video recorded and appropriate consent should be obtained from foreign faculty.

- 5. Institute will ensure that the course coordinator will not violate copyright of anyone knowingly or willingly for the preparation of course material.
- 6. Institute shall send a course completion report along with soft copy of course materials and video recording of the course within 30 days after completion of the course.
- 7. The account where this fund is kept shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by Comptroller and Audit General of India under provision CAG (DPC) act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of MHRD, Dept of Higher education, whenever the grantee is called upon to do so.


Dear Dr Guha,

This has reference to your letter dated 10 August 2015 forwarding a proposal and budget for organizing a Refresher Course in Tripura University. The Joint Science Education Panel of the three Academies will be happy to sponsor and support the Lecture Workshop. We note that Prof. R. Srinivasan will be the Course Director and you will be the Course Co-ordinator.

- (a) Your budget of Rs 7,22,200/- for 35 participants (exclusive of **travel expenses**) for Resource Persons has been approved by the Science Education Panel. The sanctioned amount is exclusive of Rs. 50,000/- which is the contribution from the host institute as mentioned in your budget.
- (b) Please note that only the names of Convener and Coordinator of the Workshop should be included in brochure/invitation etc. Names of members of the management, organizing committees, patrons etc should be strictly avoided.
- (c) As the Refresher Course is an all India one, it has to be advertised in our journals **RESONANCE** and **CURRENT SCIENCE** (copy of a typical announcement is attached). Please send us a draft of your announcement.
- (d) Applications should be submitted online through a link which will be available in our website. The Course Director and Coordinator will be provided a user-id/password to enable them to view the applications and make the selections.
- (e) Refresher Courses are sponsored and supported by the three National Science Academies IASc, INSA and NASI. The names of INDIAN ACADEMY OF SCIENCES (BANGALORE), INDIAN NATIONAL SCIENCE ACADEMY (NEW DELHI) and THE NATIONAL ACADEMY OF SCIENCES, INDIA (ALLAHABAD) should therefore be mentioned in all publicity material such as programme sheet, invitation cards, etc.







- (f) The Course should be called "Science Academies' Refresher Course in "Experimental Physics".
- (g) Please send 4-5 copies of the printed programme when ready.
- (h) Funds for organizing the Course can be sent as an advance by electronic transfer. This can be sent after a bank account is opened and the following details are provided to us:
