Girls Hostel within **26-03-2021** by depositing **Rs. 4100/-** (Admission Fee: Rs.1200.00 + Seat Rent: Rs. 900.00 + Caution Money: Rs. 2000.00) as Hostel Fees [The fee for the SC/ST students is **Rs. 3100/-** (Admission fee Rs. 500.00 + Seat Rent: Rs. 600.00 + Caution Money: Rs. 2000.00)] through online as provided in the Tripura University website (**Link: esis.tripurauniv.in**) by using Debit Card/ Credit Card/ Net Banking facilities. In all Subsequent Semesters P.G. students are to pay fees excluding Caution Money. Hostel Fees for every semester has to be cleared along with the semester Fees.

SOPs issued for Hostellers in accordance with the directions laid down in Clause No. 4.2.3 of the UGC Guidelines for Re-opening the Universities and Colleges Post Lockdown due to COVID-19 Pandemic dated 5th November 2020

1. Symptomatic students shall not be allowed under any circumstances.
2. Students seeking entry into P.G. Gents & P.G. Girls Hostels need to produce COVID-19 test negative (RT PCR) Report. Rapid Antigen Test Report for COVID will not be accepted.

3. Students to be permitted in phases with a maximum of 25 students in each batch per P.G. Hostel. Such students need to undergo a 14 days period of compulsory self-isolation within their rooms and self-monitor their health status.
4. During self-isolation, students shall clean their rooms by themselves.
5. Thermal screening before entry in each Hostel shall be carried out.
6. Hostellers should compulsorily use Face masks and sanitiser of their own.
7. There should be no crowding in hostel areas where students live in close proximity and share common facilities and utilities.
8. In case of necessity, they will be referred to the nearest COVID treatment facility for clinical assessment and treatment.
9. Density in dining halls, common rooms, playing areas should be limited, keeping in view the requirement of physical distancing.
10. Hygiene conditions should be regularly monitored in kitchens, dining halls, bathrooms and toilets etc.
11. Cleanliness is to be maintained in dining areas. Meals should be served in small batches, avoiding over-crowding. Take away options should be available for students and staff.
12. It must be ensured that the meals are freshly cooked. A senior staff should monitor the same.
13. Utensils should be properly cleaned.
14. Wearing of face cover/ masks and proper sanitization of hands of the staff engaged for the preparation and distribution of meals should be ensured.
15. Resident students and staff should avoid or limit visiting the markets.
16. Hostels wardens may define the number of students in dining halls at any point in time. Mess timings may be increased to avoid overcrowding.
17. Any symptomatic student should be sent to the TU Health Centre for further check-up.

The above-mentioned students may be allowed to enter the hostel premises from 22.03.2021.
