Brief Summary of the Panel Discussion

.....How Ramsar sites will be conserved? The most resourceful Rudrosagar wetland in Tripura, Loktak lake in Manipur and Chilka lake in Orissa knocking us to think over their conservation. Most of the lentic ecosystem have concentrated their size and shape due to greatly reducing their depth because of severe shortage of water. During winter period many more lentic as well as lotic ecosystem could not be identified with their actual morphometry. To restore them mass awareness be initiated immediately. At the same time proper conservation strategies have to be adopted in field to conserve the aquatic fauna especially endangered, threatened, vulnerable, rare species etc..

Forest cover of the country depicting a gradual decreasing trend during last three decades. The situation is more pathetic in the North East India which is considered as one of the Biodiversity Hot Spots of the country. If we are to think over Eco-restoration, we need to revisit the mandates of CBD and Indian Biodiversity Act 2002. To develop strategy for income generation for the rural people, all biodiversity conservation approach should be linked together for Ecosystem restoration. Forest Diversity conservation be ensured by making MBCs functional and making the concept of fair and equitable sharing of benefits arising out of utilization of Bio resources operational.....
