**OVERVIEW:**

From the various government policies, it is well appeared that the concern of reproductive and child health is gaining increasing importance over time in India with the space of the country's development. Tripura with all her ethno-demographic, cultural and geographical diversities is no exception in this regard. Recently, the National Health Mission (NHM), Tripura has proposed us to conduct an evaluation study of the status of Reproductive and Child Health (RCH) for the slum dwellers in Agartala. The broad objective is to find out the relative positions of the slum dwellers of Agartala in terms of RCH status.

To cope up with such evaluation study, a comprehensive and systematic approach is necessary. Starting from the selection of respondents without any bias; authentication and validation of data; choices of appropriate methodology to analyze the data; and above all proper interpretation of data require a specialized, multi-disciplinary and multi-dimensional approach. Hence, a hands-on-training to enable the trainee field investigators, data entry operators and research assistants is essential. Accordingly, to equip the participants for handling the research issues; make them understand about the field level difficulties in the Research Areas of RCH and deal with the survey data analysis, this 2-Day Workshop-cum-Training Programme will be arranged.
