Text: 12 pt, 1.5 line spacing. The abstract must clearly indicate

the problem, methodology, and result of the work, and include 4-6

key words. The word limit is 250.

Posters should be in portrait and must measure 3 ft in width and 4 ft in height.

AWARDS

Awards for outstanding research will be given to the best three oral presentations and best three poster presentations.
