Ph.D. COURSEWORK NOTIFICATION **(ACADEMIC SESSION 2025–26)**

As per Clause 12 of the Ph.D. Regulations- 2024 (Revised) of Tripura University (in accordance with the UGC [Minimum Standards & Procedure for Awards of M.Phil./Ph.D Degree] Regulations, 2022) and in continuation of the admission notification for the Academic Session 2025–26, it is hereby notified that the Ph.D. Coursework for all provisionally admitted scholars Vide Notification No. F.TU/Admission/Ph. D./01/2025 dated 03/12/2025 shall commence from 16th February 2026 in their respective Departments.

All provisionally admitted Ph.D. scholars are required to pursue the prescribed coursework of one semester (minimum 14 credits) as mandated under University Regulations and in conformity with the prevailing UGC guidelines.

Course Structure and Credits: The Ph.D. Coursework shall comprise the following components:

The detailed syllabus, course structure, and reference materials shall be made available by the respective Departmental Heads/Head (i/c)/Coordinators.

Attendance and Examination: A minimum of 75% attendance in each course is mandatory to appear in the coursework examination. After completing the course work, the scholar shall appear in a comprehensive examination.

Scholars must obtain: A minimum of 55% marks (equivalent to B Grade) in each course or a minimum CGPA of 6.00 in the coursework to be eligible to continue in the Ph.D. programme. The grading system shall follow the absolute grading pattern as prescribed by the University.

All concerned scholars are advised to contact their respective Heads of Departments for detailed class schedules and further instructions. No separate individual communication shall be issued in this regard.
