He emphasized that acquiring skills, knowledge, and critical thinking should take precedence over merely earning certificates. Chancellor Ahmed Javed, in his speech, praised the university's commitment not only to education but also to social service. He lauded the faculty and students for their response to the recent floods in Tripura, particularly highlighting the invention of a portable water purifier by a faculty member. # Relief distribution by TU economics alumni

A large number of people in the area have lost their houses, belongings, and means of subsistence as a result of the devastating event. 


