NOTIFICATION

This is for information to all concerned that the Government of India has already declared to all Educational Institutions to be made Tobacco-Free for which the following things to be maintained:

1.	Signage Display	'Tobacco Free Zone' or 'Tobacco Free Educational Institution' signage must be prominently displayed at the main entrance, on every floor, and in common areas like libraries and washrooms.
2.	Awareness Programmes	Conduct atleast two awareness sessions or sensitization workshops per academic year focused on the ill affects of tobacco and other substance abuse within the campus.
3.	Designation of Officers	Nominate one Teacher/Faculty Member as the Nodal Officer and one or two students as Tobacco Monitors to actively monitor the campus environment and ensure compliance with these norms.

In this connection, Dr. Vishav Bandhu, Associate Professor, Department of Sanskrit, T.U., has been nominated as the 'Nodal Officer' for ensuring strict compliance with the directives and for promoting a healthy and safe learning environment for all students and staff of the University.
