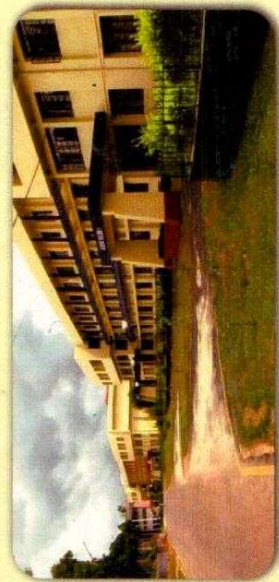

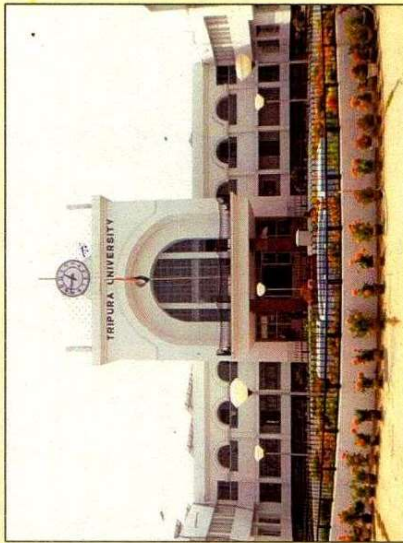

Prologue

The picturesque state of Tripura, the second smallest in terms of area but the second most populous state in the North Eastern Region is characterised by huge ethnic diversity and geographical isolation from the heartland of India, like other states of the North Eastern Region. The average temperature of Agartala, the Capital of Tripura varies between 20°C-30°C in the month of April.

The University: The beginning of Tripura University can be traced back with the establishment of Calcutta University Post-Graduate Centre at Maharaja Bir Bikram College in the year 1976. On 2nd October 1987, Tripura University formally came into being as a State University at the College Tilla Campus of MBB College, Tripura University converted into a Central University by an Act of the Indian Parliament since 2nd July, 2007. The present campus of Tripura University is located about 18 km. away from Maharaja Bir Bikram Airport, Agartala and 5 km. from Agartala Railway Station towards the south.

The Department: The Department of Economics, Tripura University was established in the year 1978 as a Post-Graduate Department under the Faculty of Science during the Calcutta University Post-Graduate Centre regime. Presently, the Department offers M.A., M.L.Sc. and Integrated Master Degree courses and has developed research facilities leading to Ph. D. degree.

The Theme of the Seminar: There has been stark and persistent inter-region and inter-state disparity in India with respect to major economic and social indicators. The problem of economic and social disparity is more serious in the Northeastern Region of India with huge ethnic diversity and communication bottleneck. A large body of recent literature has shown that the economic reform adopted in 1991 has accentuated the problem of regional imbalance; highlighting absolute divergence and conditional convergence. In order to reduce regional imbalances and disparity, the Government of India has initiated a series of policy actions. A special focus has been given to the Northeastern States of India through Look East to Act East Policy. However, the outcomes of the

policy actions are yet to reach at their desired level. Particularly, the NER states of India are not uniform in nature and their structural diversity calls for region specific in-depth study.

The proposed National Seminar on Development Paradigm is not only confined to Economics, rather it is multidisciplinary in nature. The outcomes of the Seminar are expected to generate fruitful insight among the academicians and researchers in social sciences. The development practitioners/policy implementers can understand properly the emerging policy issues of inclusive development in the context of Northeastern Region of India. Especially, the proposed Panel Discussion on "*Ethnicity and Social Exclusion: The Northeast India Perspective*" with invited resource persons, may be of particular importance in understanding the issues concerning sustainable development of the Northeastern India.

Abstract with a suitable title must be written in English within 300 words along with maximum of three keywords.

Title: Maximum length - 15 words.

Author(s): Affiliation should be clearly mentioned. In case of multiple authors, corresponding author should be mentioned properly.

Text: Normal, Times New Roman Font & 12 point indent (Compatible Mode).

Reference: Author (s) should follow the latest APA style of referencing system.

Word Limit of the Full Paper: Full paper should be written within 6000 words.

The Seminar Proceeding Volume will be published.

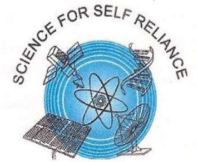
