Proceedings of the 1st meeting of the Board of Faculty of Studies of Arts & Commerce held on 6th August, 2013 at 11:00 a.m. in the Conference Hall of Tripura University.

The inaugural session of the 1st meeting of the Board of Faculty of Studies was chaired by the Vice-Chancellor of Tripura University. In his inaugural speech he welcomed all the members present in the meeting and apprised them of the power and functions on the Board of Faculty of Studies. He also requested the members to take responsibilities of the tasks conferred upon the Board of Faculty of Studies. After setting the functionaries of Board of Faculty of Studies (Arts & Commerce), Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor left the meeting hall with a request to the Dean of Arts & Commerce, T.U. to take over the chair.

Thereafter, the Dean of Arts & Commerce and Chairperson of the Board of Faculty of Studies of Arts & Commerce Faculty welcomed the members and gave his heartiest thanks to the three outside members Prof. Dinesh Kr. Pandiya, Prof. Himadri Lahiri and Dr. Bidhan Chandra Pal for making themselves available to attend the 1st meeting of the Board of Faculty of Studies of Arts & Commerce, Tripura University. Then the discussion was started agenda wise.

Agenda 1:

To consider the reports of the adjudicators and viva-voce examiners for the award of Ph. D. Degree to Mr. Sarat Kumar Das, Department of Political Science, TU

The reports of the adjudicators and the reports of the viva-voce examinations of above mentioned candidate were read by Sri Narendu Bhattacharya, Deputy Registrar and the Chairman had asked the house if anybody would like to comment on the reports. On this, Dr. Gautam Chakma, Member of the Committee had raised a question stating that in the reports of the experts there was not any mention about the relations of Political Science with the Disaster Management and he desired to know from the house how Political Science is related with the Disaster Management which was in the title of the thesis of Mr. Sarat Kumar Das. Thereafter, Prof. K.N. Jena, Supervisor of the candidate and also one of the members of the committee had explained that Disaster Management might not be written in the reports of the adjudicators and viva-voce examiners. However, he stated that details were written in the original thesis of the candidate and Political Science could and can be related to Disaster Management. Prof. Dinesh Kr. Pandiya, one of the members also gave his deliberation on the issue and stated that to know in detail regarding the title of the thesis one's had to go through in the original thesis of the candidate. Then, on the basis of the reports of the adjudicators and viva-voce examiners the members agreed upon to resolve to recommend award of Ph.D. Degree to Mr. Sarat Kumar Das in Political Science

on the title: **“Administrative Reforms and Disaster Management: A Case Study of Tripura State”** under the supervision of Prof. K.N. Jena, Department of Political Science, TU.
