





Out of 83 responses, 66 percent of the teaching staff strongly agree and 30 percent of the teaching staff agree that the vision, philosophy and objectives are known to them.


Aims and objectives of the syllabi are well defined and clear to teachers and students. 83 responses

The course/programme of studies carries sufficient number of optional papers.



Programmes outcomes of the syllabi is well defined



Curriculum having good academic flexibility



The course content fulfills the need of students




























Out of 83 responses, 40 percent of the teaching staff strongly agree and 43 percent of the teaching staff agree that officers are approachable and accessible.
