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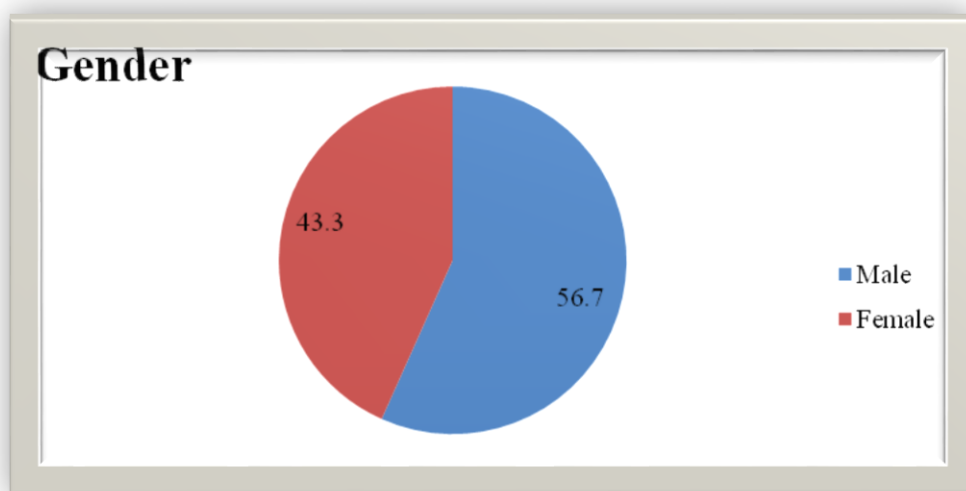

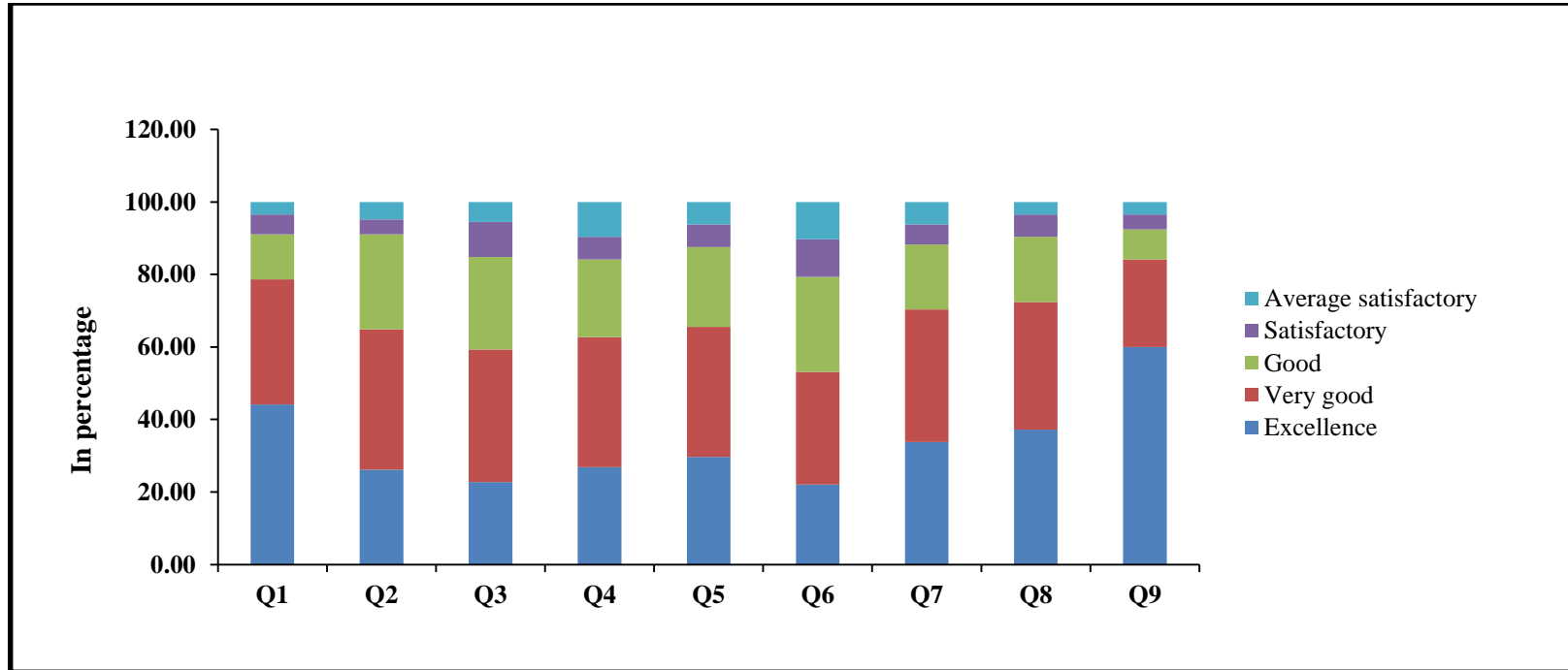
The students are the pivotal point of a University system. It is for their overall development and academic training that the university works tirelessly, with the teachers directly interacting with the students; the supporting staff, examination section, and the administration facilitating this process by making the overall journey from admission to passing out smooth and effective for the students. For smooth functioning of the entire system, each segment has to be allowed to work with reasonable comfort with an idea about the assessment of their performance at the institution. While student's performance is assessed during examinations, the performance of the teachers and the staff in terms of the perspective of the students, alumni and parents are assessed through their feedback which is collected online each year. It is essential to create a general awareness among the community about the university functioning and attempts to strengthening its teaching learning activity. In this context it is pertinent to obtain the feedback from the related community (alumni and parents of the students) about the University. In that process, feedback is collected from all stakeholders namely students, alumni, parents, faculty and administrative staff about their perception about the University functioning. To ensure that the teachers and the staff are provided the working environment conducive to effective performance, their feedback about the University is also collected in a similar manner. In order to strength the University system further and ensure satisfaction of all the stakeholders it is essential to not only obtain their feedback, but to analyze them carefully and ensure adequate measures to reduce the weaknesses and threats while converting the opportunities into strength.

The feedbacks received from the alumni were collated, analyzed and the data were represented graphically (in percentage) as shown below.

Suggestions for further improvement

1. Enroll more students per course and build the departments, campus and infrastructure further to add glory to the University. Branches of university should be set up in North and South Tripura. Infrastructure like smart class room, IT lab, Scholars room, WIFI facility, Faculty room, smart seminar halls, recreational facilities, departmental library shall be developed in the Department.
2. The syllabus should be revised at UG as well as PG level to incorporate the content needed for UGC NET and also provide classes for NET coaching. The syllabus should be at par with national and industrial needs.
3. UG in Rural studies need to be opened in the colleges. UGC needs to be approached to include Rural Studies as a subject of NET examination. Field visit & work should be done in intensive/aspirational villages & blocks. Departments shall undertake Research projects in various sector of Rural Development. "Importance of Skilling & its implication in Rural Youths to boost Rural economy" should be introduced in the course curriculum. Non- financial MoU may be signed between University & Govt. Departments dealing various Rural Development projects.
4. Any undue interference into University functioning should be stopped to ensure free and fair recruitment and operation.
5. Campus recruitment for final semester students should be further strengthened to ensure better employment to passing out students. Startup related certificate courses should be introduced for promotion of Entrepreneurship.
6. Add departments like Archeology; courses like MPEd, more of field activity; training and internships; more project facilities to foster practical skills and real-world application of knowledge. It is essential to encourage greater engagement and active participation from both students and faculty members.
7. Introducing a variety of co-curricular as well as sports activities is crucial for the holistic development of students.
8. Library books issue needs to be increased.
9. Admission fee is high for the students
10. A stronger tie with alumni with regular email correspondence, reunions, a dedicated section, air marked room for alumni association and a dedicated portal for information circulation can ensure better contribution of alumni towards University development.

11. There should be more student bodies like Student council.
12. Recruit more faculties with emphasis on local candidates. Remuneration of guest faculties should be increased.
13. University should have policy to shuffle the officials periodically; .
14. Physical education department needs a gymnasium hall, international infrastructure, high quality equipment, synthetic ground, one iron gym, Synthetic track is required.

Action Taken


The observation of the Alumni is positive and encouraging.

Suggestions for further improvement:

1. According to suggestion one, student enrollment cannot be enhanced as it is based on available resources. It is pertinent to mention that there are departments with vacant seats after following the UGC norms for admission.
2. The point is not pertinent, since the core and elective courses are chosen from various categories. The courses are designed by all the teachers and for undergraduate courses, the syllabus is designed taking into consideration the views of college faculty representative for each subject.
3. We are trying to encourage such activities. However, it depends on the state government.
4. In this regard proper care has been taken.
5. Campus recruitment is not possible for some of the departments. However, a dedicated team for placement is in place and the opportunities are improving with time. Skill courses as well as awareness programs for promoting entrepreneurship leading to setting up of startups are organized from time to time and these activities will be further intensified in near future. Employment generation Resource Centre/Skill development center are already in place for this purpose.
6. New departments like Archeology and courses like MPed is ongoing. Adequate care is taking regarding the student projects keeping in mind the regional demands, available resources and faculty expertise to ensure generation of trained manpower as per National demand, so that both the students and the faculties are benefited.
7. Variety of co-curricular activities has increased in the last few years. Still efforts have been made by the University to further improve it.
8. We are taking care of it. It is pertinent to mention that there are unutilized books in the library.
9. Admission fee is not on the higher end. This is as per the norms laid down by the Government of India.
10. This has already been brought to the notice of the Secretary of the alumni association.
11. Proper care can be taken to consider such councils, though its alternative forms are there in place with student nominees in different committees.
12. The drive for recruitment of more faculties has already been started with 40 new faculties added in the last year. The process is continuing.
13. This has already in place.
14. We are trying to improve in this regard. However, the open gym already exists in addition to the pre-existing facilities.


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
