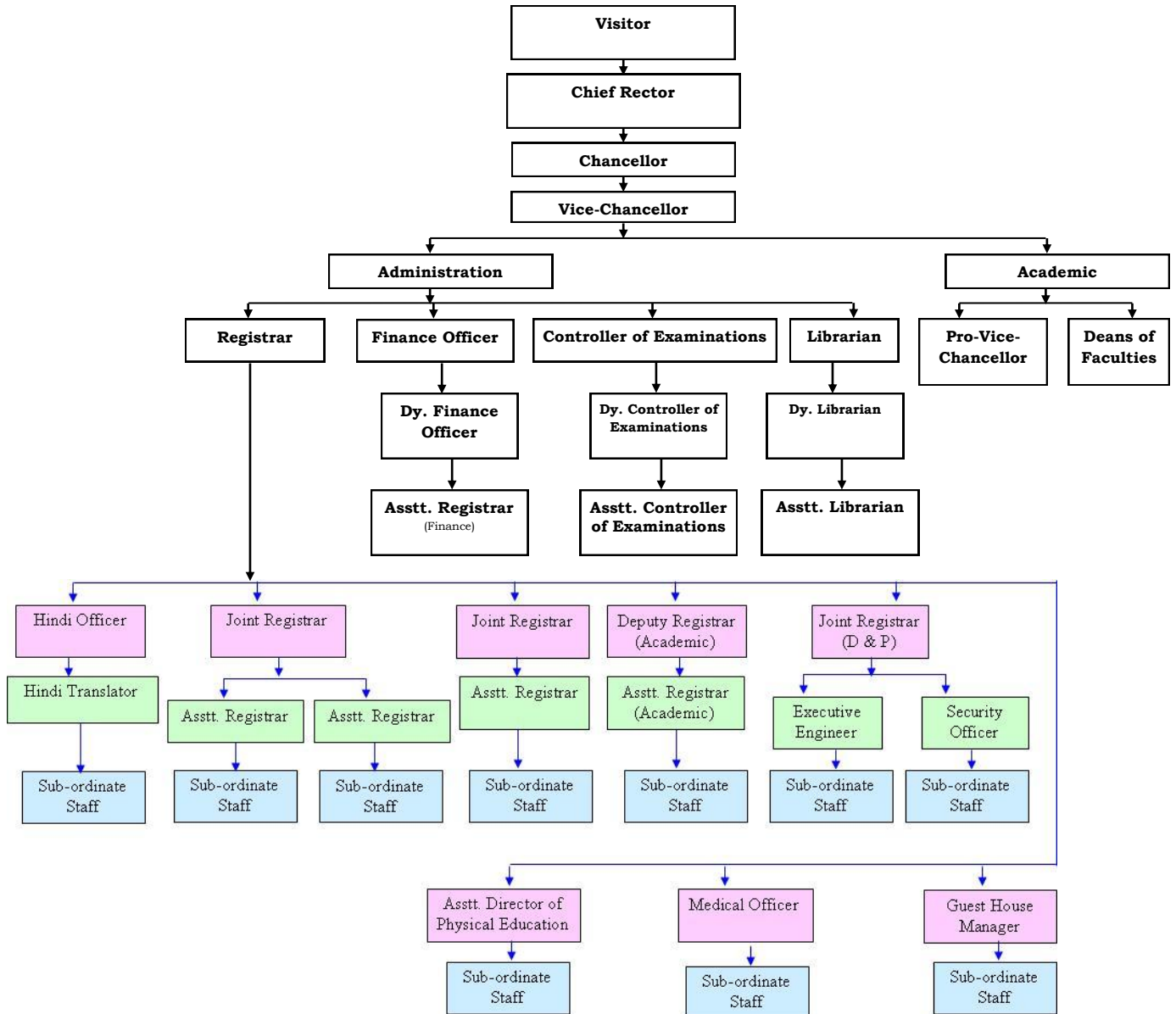

- **Student Feedback on Institutional Governance/ Faculty performance**

Student feedback has not been implemented. But, faculty performance is judged based on their research and publications.
