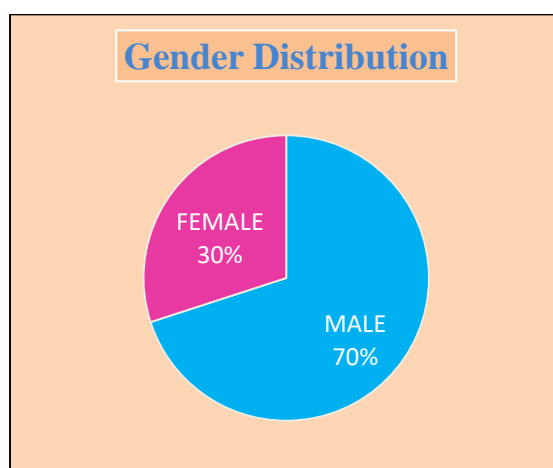

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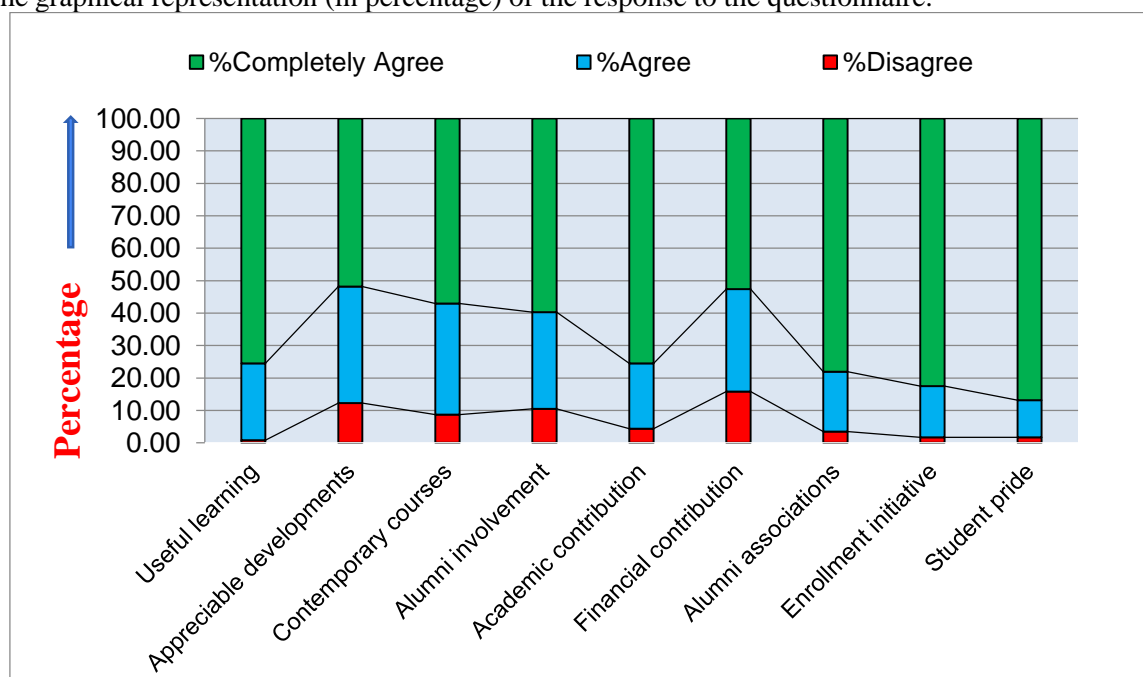

They are an important pillar in formation of the perception about the university. The University regularly collects alumni input to assess performance, identify areas for improvement, and enhance teaching and learning. Responses are analyzed to gauge perceptions regarding academic standards, administrative efficiency, and institutional development, which influence policy refinement and engagement initiatives.

The 2024–2025 Alumni Feedback survey highlighted positive alumni perceptions regarding the relevance of academic learning to career growth, the recognition of updated course offerings, and appreciation for recent institutional advancements. Alumni also expressed a strong desire to contribute both academically and financially, while calling for stronger departmental alumni associations.

How I have contributed to the Universities development as an alumni:

**CONTRIBUTION OF ALUMNI:**

1. The alumni have mentored students, delivered industry talks, facilitated internships, advised on curriculum revisions, organized alumni networking, and supported scholarships to enhance academic quality and employability. They have also supported students financially and socially through voluntary activities and departmental projects. Additionally, they have shared notifications and organized various interactive sessions to prepare students for corporate job interviews.
2. They have been actively involved in University activities and, as current research scholars they have contributed to University publications and projects. Some alumni have also served in teaching positions at the University, thereby contributing to manpower training.

**SUGGESTIONS BY ALUMNI:**

1. A Departmental Placement Cell may be created.
2. More on-campus recruiting process may be introduced.
3. Need to collaborate with the state and the Central Government for successful placement and internship.
4. Suggesting the intensification of industry academia collaboration, enhanced career guidance initiatives, and greater alumni student interface programs, which would collectively augment the University's academic rigor and professional relevance.
5. A dedicated website and real-time alumni member data, their extraordinary career growth, contributions, online registration, unique alumni member registration number, alumni member ID card, online facility for contribution on the same website, important past event photos, videos, monthly newsletter, and alumni email ID with Tripura University domain name on annual payment basis for interested persons may be created.
6. Alumni Association should have an office at University premises so that it can be operated in physical mode, and perhaps it will jointly work with the Training & Placement team.
7. Alumni engagement should be strengthened through regular or at least biennial (including department-wise) meet-and-greet programs to enhance student job opportunities, foster connections, and support newcomers.
8. Additional programs may be included in pharmacy profession.
9. NE SLET in Kokborok subject may be introduced.
10. Vacancies in PG courses may be increased.
11. Seat capacity in the department of Kokborok may be increased to more than 100.
12. There is a significant need for more faculties across departments—ensure that each department has at least five regular Assistant Professors.
13. Equal opportunity should be provided through a transparent mode ensuring a better perception of the university among the stakeholders, while restoring efficiency and fairness.



14. Campus security should ensure respectful interactions with students.
15. The university should promote unity among all departments, and students should be encouraged to replace negative attitudes with positivity
16. Organizing mental health camps may be encouraged.
17. Creation of additional student forums.
18. The university may organize convocation every year.
19. Tripura University needs cleaning more efficiently and dispose of the dustbins regularly.
20. A whole University exhibition program or science exhibition in a year is needed where each student can show their work to all.
21. Consider building or installing statues of the Maharajas and Maharani of Tripura on the University campus.
22. To build a museum on the University campus with traditional items, folk materials, folk instruments, folk dance, and cultural artifacts of Tripura.
23. To construct a Mini Park using the water bodies or reservoir of the University campus and build Gairing or traditional houses on both sides.
