

- **A Big Goal for Enrollment:** One of the major goals of NEP 2020 is to increase the Gross Enrollment Ratio (GER) in higher education from 26.3% (in 2018) to 50% by the year 2035.
- **No Hard Separations:** NEP 2020 promotes multidisciplinary education, allowing students to choose creative combinations of subjects without rigid separations between 'arts', 'commerce', and 'science' streams.



## WHAT IS THE ACADEMIC BANK OF CREDITS (ABC)?

Think of the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) as a digital "bank account" for your education. It's a core part of the NEP 2020's vision for a more flexible, student-centric learning system.



**Digital Credit Storage:** Your ABC ID links to a central digital repository. Every time you complete a course, your university "deposits" the credits you earned into this account. This creates a secure, verified, and permanent record of all your academic achievements.
