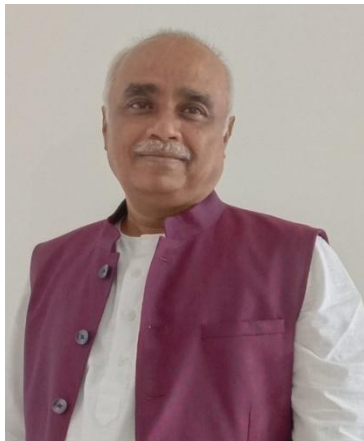



Tripura University is oldest and a dedicated higher educational institution committed to the cause of

developing and empowering the people of this state and the region by imparting quality education and technological innovations in the field of academic and research activities.

Tripura University is one of the 54 Central Universities in India. It was established as a State University on 2 October 1987 under the Tripura University Act and later became a Central University on 2 July 2007 through an Act of Parliament. The university originated from a Post Graduate Centre of University of Calcutta established in 1976.

The university campus is located at Suryamaninagar, about 9 km from Agartala. It was developed on a 75-acre green campus with the aim of establishing a full-fledged university in the state.

Tripura University offers 69 academic programmes including certificate courses, undergraduate programmes, postgraduate degrees, postgraduate diplomas and Ph.D. programmes in more than 40 subjects through 44 departments under the 5 faculties Viz.,

Commerce, Law, Management and Information Science; Literature; Music and Fine Arts; Social Sciences and Science. The university also has 65 affiliated colleges consisting of 29 General Degree Colleges, 21 Professional Colleges, 12 Allied and Healthcare and Nursing Colleges and 3 Medical Colleges.

The main objective of the university is to disseminate and advance knowledge through teaching and research, with special emphasis on tribal studies, culture, and vocational education to improve employment opportunities. The university is known for promoting academic excellence, research, innovation and collaboration with national and international institutions which is truly reflected in its motto: 'utkrshata Ka Lakshya' 'उत्कृष्टताकालक्ष्य' (Pursuit of Excellence).

The President of India is the Visitor and the Governor of Tripura is the Chief Rector.

Study at TRIPURA UNIVERSITY



Studying at Tripura University offers students opportunities for quality higher education and research. The university attracts students from all over India but more appropriately from different parts of Eastern India and neighbouring Bangladesh.

The academic programmes are designed to combine theoretical knowledge with practical learning. Departments organize seminars, workshops, research projects and fieldwork to enhance students' academic skills.

Learning Environment

Tripura University provides a peaceful and inspiring learning environment. The campus is surrounded by lakes, forests, hillocks and gardens, creating a serene atmosphere that supports academic concentration and personal development.

The university campus includes facilities such as hostels, health centre, playgrounds, open theatre, bank, cafeteria, post office and food courts.

A wide range of sports, cultural and social activities like debates, film screenings, musical performances, art festivals, walkathons and sports tournaments are organized regularly. These activities help students develop leadership, creativity and teamwork.



Library System

The Central Library of Tripura University acts as a major knowledge hub supporting teaching, learning and research activities. The library provides a wide collection of books, journals, manuscripts, theses and digital resources for students and researchers.

The library has implemented a fully computerized system and offers online databases, remote access services and digital repositories. Through the Institutional Digital Repository, research materials such as journal articles, theses, dissertations and conference papers created by the university community are preserved and shared.



Laboratories

Tripura University has well-equipped laboratories across various departments to support scientific learning and research. These laboratories provide facilities for practical training, experimentation and advanced research in fields such as science, technology and media studies.

Many departments are supported by central instrumentation facilities, ICT laboratories, internet facilities and Wi-Fi connectivity. These facilities allow students and researchers to work with modern equipment and technology for academic and research purposes.



Placement

Tripura University emphasizes career development and employability of students. The university maintains collaborations with various institutions and industries to provide training, internships and placement opportunities.

Many students secure employment in government services, research institutions, banks, educational institutions, media houses and private companies.

Skill-based and practical courses are also offered to prepare students for professional careers and entrepreneurship. Several departments maintain strong placement records, with graduates working across India and abroad.



Registrations and Admission to Undergraduate, Integrated Masters Degree and Postgraduate Programmes

INDIAN NATIONALS

The candidate must be a citizen of India. For admission to Undergraduate, Integrated Masters' Degree, Postgraduate Diploma and Postgraduate programs at Tripura University all candidates (including those applying under supernumerary quota) must appear for CUET (UG)-2026 and CUET (PG)-2026, respectively.

Important:

- Admissions to all the Undergraduate, Integrated Masters' Degree and Postgraduate programs (except Foreign Students) will be done through Tripura University Admission Portal (<https://tripuraunivcuetsamarth.edu.in>).
- Details related to admission will be notified separately on the Tripura University Website (<https://tripurauniv.ac.in>). Candidates must visit the admission section of Tripura University website on a regular basis.

FOREIGN NATIONALS

Candidates seeking admission under the Foreign Students' category are required to apply on Study in India Portal (<https://www.studyinindia.gov.in/>) and subsequently should complete the online application process for admission on (<https://tripuraunivfsradm.samarth.edu.in>). Fifteen per cent (15%) of Supernumerary seats in each Programme are reserved for Foreign Nationals.

Separate notification shall be made for admission of International students. International students need not appear in CUET - 2026, but he/ she must fulfill the eligibility criteria of 60% or its equivalent grade in qualifying Examination.

Students who have appeared in the final qualifying examination in 2026 or shall appear in the qualifying examination in 2026 may also apply. However, if they fail to produce their transcript with requisite percentage, their admission shall automatically be cancelled.

IMPORTANT POINTS

1. This e-Prospectus serves as a reference for admission to Undergraduate, Integrated Master's Degree, Postgraduate Diploma and Postgraduate programmes at Tripura University through CUET (UG) 2026 and CUET (PG) 2026. Admissions to all these programmes will be based solely on the scores obtained in the Common University Entrance Test (UG/PG) 2026.
2. Tripura University will offer admission to its Undergraduate, Integrated Master's Degree, Postgraduate Diploma and Postgraduate programmes for the academic session 2026–27 through CUET (UG) 2026 and CUET (PG) 2026, conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA), in accordance with UGC guidelines.
3. Students interested in UG/IMD programs shall fill up online applications forms in NTA portal <https://cuet.nta.nic.in/> for admission test within 03rd January to 26th February 2026 (up to 11.50 PM).
4. Students interested in PG programs shall fill up online application forms in NTA portal <https://exams.nta.nic.in/cuet-pg/> for admission test within 14th December 2025 to 14th January 2026 (up to 11:50 P.M.).
5. Foreign Nationals seeking admission to TU must register at Study in India Portal (<https://www.studyinindia.gov.in/>) and subsequently on admission section of (<https://tripurauniv.ac.in>).
6. Before registering for CUET (UG/PG) - 2026, the candidate is advised to read the e-Prospectus carefully and consult the Tripura University Act, 2006. The Ordinances, Rules, and Regulations of TU, available on the University website, would be binding to the candidate.
7. Candidates are advised to ascertain that they fulfill the Minimum Eligibility Criteria.
8. Before appearing in CUET (UG/PG) – 2026, candidates must ensure that they fulfill the Programme-Specific Eligibility. They must appear in the CUET paper as per the requirements of the specific programme.
9. Candidates appearing in the qualifying degree examination/candidates whose results are awaited, are eligible to appear in CUET (UG/PG) - 2026. However, they must fulfill the Minimum Eligibility Criteria at the time of admission by submitting necessary undertaking.
10. Only the scores obtained in CUET (UG/PG) - 2026 will be considered for admissions to Undergraduate, Integrated Masters' Degree, Postgraduate Diploma and Postgraduate Programmes at TU for the academic year 2026-27. However, if seats remain vacant in any Programme after conducting admission through CUET 2026, Tripura University shall be free to conduct admission either through Merit List or Tripura University Entrance Test conducted for that program.
11. Merit will be based solely on the scores obtained in the CUET Test Paper (except for Programmes where Audition test/Practical based test/Sports proficiency test etc. are mandatory) as per the requirement of the specific programme.

12. Candidates are advised to check that they satisfy all eligibility criteria for the programme(s) for which they are appearing in the entrance test. Admission is subject to the candidate's fulfilling the eligibility requirements prescribed for the concerned programme. In case, a candidate does not meet any of the eligibility criteria prescribed for applying to the concerned programme and appears in the entrance test, it is at the candidate's own risk and cost. If at any stage, it is found that eligibility requirement/s is/are not fulfilled, and/or if the claim/s made by the candidate with respect to his/her category, gender, etc. is/are found to be invalid, the admission, if granted, shall be cancelled ipso facto. Appropriate legal action will be taken against such a candidate.
13. Candidates seeking admission to the TU after the declaration of CUET 2026 results are required to register/apply through the Tripura University Admission Portal, named as CUET-UG 2026-27; CUET-PG 2026-27 admission using their CUET application number as and when notified by TU (kindly refer to admission section of website- <https://tripuraunivcuetsamarth.edu.in>)
14. Candidate must be careful while filling the CUET(UG/PG)-2026 form as certain fields such as Name, signature and photograph of the candidate will be later auto-integrated by TU from the CUET (UG/PG)-2026 portal. These fields will be non-editable in the TU's admission portal.
15. Applicants may apply for a maximum of three programs. Applicants will have to apply separately for each program. The entire process of application (like registration, submission of requisite fees, filling up online form etc.) will have to be repeated for every program applied for by the applicant.
16. The sanctioned seat intake for each of the programs during the academic session 2026-27 is mentioned against each programmes offered. However, the intake capacity of any department(s) may be increased or decreased at the last moment of admission procedure if Tripura University authority desires so.
17. The University is not bound to fill all the supernumerary seats.
18. The Fee Structure is mentioned against each programme for UG/IMD and PG Programs. Persons with Disability (PWD) with disability percentage of 40 or more are exempted from paying Admission/Semester Fees. However, an alumni Fee of Rs. 200/- for UG and PG students and Rs 1000/- from Ph. D. students shall be collected at the time of Admission.
19. TU will conduct counseling of the candidates who have applied/registered to various undergraduate (UG), IMD, PG Diploma and Postgraduate (PG) programs of the University. In this regard, the Tripura University shall notify the counseling dates in TU Website. All the information related to counseling process will be notified and uploaded on the University website
20. All the "Honours" qualified candidates will be eligible to apply, however for the "Pass" qualified candidates a minimum eligibility marks will be 50% (for UR) and 45% (for SC/ST) in the preceding qualifying examination.

21. However, for the departments affiliated with the statutory bodies, respective guidelines shall be followed.
22. After the counseling, the merit list of UG, IMD, PG Diploma and PG programs in the different departments will be declared. For admission, all candidates will be considered in the common merit list (except the supernumerary seats).
23. The selected candidates can secure their admission to the UG, IMD and PG programs by paying the program fee through online mode. If any student fails to secure admission within the due date, his/her seat shall be offered to the next candidate from the waiting list.
24. The University is not bound to fill all the supernumerary seats.
25. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS/PwBD will have to upload a valid certificate/document while applying to Tripura University. The name of the candidate claiming reservation must match with the candidate's name as it appears on his/her corresponding School/Board/qualifying examination certificates and in CUET (UG/PG)-2026. Similarly, the parents' names must also match in all the certificates/documents.
26. Gap year will not be a bar for the purpose of admission to Undergraduate, Integrated Masters' Degree, and Postgraduate Programmes in TU.
27. As per Ordinance of the University, there is no minimum age bar for admission to the Undergraduate, Integrated Masters' Degree and Postgraduate Programmes in TU except in the programmes where the respective regulatory bodies, such as All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE), Bar Council of India (BCI), National Council of Teacher Education (NCTE), etc. have prescribed the minimum age requirement in their respective regulations.
28. Candidates admitted for the academic session 2026–27 will pursue their studies under the Curriculum Framework, in accordance with the National Education Policy (NEP)–2020. They are advised to regularly visit the Tripura University website for academic and other relevant updates.
29. Candidates are advised to regularly check the admission section of website- (<https://tripurauniv.ac.in>) for all notifications and updates. Any grievance pertaining to candidate's lack of awareness of the published information and updates shall not be entertained.
30. In case of any (i) failure in the online system (ii) failure of payment through bank, or (iii) any other unforeseen circumstances leading to failure in submission of form etc. the Tripura University authority shall not be held responsible.
31. All litigation regarding admission shall lie within the jurisdiction of the High Court of Tripura.
32. In-Service applicants required to submit NOC from the employer at the time of counseling.
33. For interpretation or explanation of any rules or any part of the rules, the decision of the Vice Chancellor, Tripura University shall be final and binding.

Eligibility Requirement for Undergraduate Programmes

The candidate must have passed Class XII or its equivalent examination from a single recognized board. For ascertaining Minimum Eligibility, the mark sheet/ degree of only one board will be considered. (For example, if a candidate has appeared in CBSE Board Examination with five subjects except for Mathematics and later appears and passes Mathematics from another board such as the National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS), the minimum eligibility shall be ascertained from his/her mark sheet issued by CBSE only).

Programme Specific Eligibilities

Candidate must refer to the Programme-Specific Eligibility to choose the subjects in which s(he) should appear in CUET (UG) – 2026

It is mandatory for the candidates to appear in CUET(UG)-2026 in those subjects in which s(he) is appearing/ has passed Class XII. For ascertaining Programme Specific Eligibility and for mapping the CUET subject(s) with Class XII subject(s), mark sheet of more than one recognized board may be considered provided the candidate has passed those subjects in Class XII.

Integrated Master Degree Programme (IMD)

The candidate must be in possession of the caste/tribe certificate in his/her own name at the time of registration and admission. The caste certificate should clearly state:

- a) name of caste/tribe
- b) whether candidate belongs to SC or ST
- c) District and the State or Union Territory of candidate's usual place of residence, and
- d) the appropriate Government of India Schedule under which the caste/tribe is approved as SC or ST

Candidate will have to produce the valid original SC/ST certificate at the time of admission. The following are empowered to issue the requisite SC/ST certificate:

- a) District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate/Collector/Deputy Commissioner/Additional Deputy Commissioner/Deputy Collector/1st class Stipendiary Magistrate/City Magistrate/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Taluka Magistrate/Executive Magistrate / Extra Assistant Commissioner District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate/Collector/Deputy Commissioner/Additional Deputy Commissioner/Deputy Collector/1st class Stipendiary Magistrate/City Magistrate/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Taluka Magistrate/Executive Magistrate / Extra Assistant Commissioner
- b) Chief Presidency Magistrate/Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/Presidency Magistrate
- c) Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar
- d) Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and/ or his family normally resides
- e) Administrator/Secretary to the Administrator/Development Officer

Candidates to note that the SC/ST certificate from any other person/authority shall not be accepted in any case. If the candidate happens to belong to SC or ST, candidate's caste / tribe must be listed in the appropriate Government of India Schedule.

It is a statutory obligation on the part of Departments/Colleges to fill all seats reserved for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe candidates.

Departments/Centers shall not refuse admission to any SC/ST candidate on the basis of medium of instruction. Any deficiency in the knowledge of any particular language should be addressed; for this purpose, remedial classes may be arranged by the Department/College by utilizing grants available from University Grants Commission.

RESERVATION OF SEATS FOR OTHER BACKWARD CLASSES (OBC NON-CREAMYLAYER)

2% of seats are reserved for candidates belonging to Other Backward Classes (OBC-Non-Creamy Layer, Central List).

At the time of giving admission to a candidate belonging to OBC-NCL, the Departments/Centres will ensure that the caste is included in the Central List of OBC (the OBC status is to be determined on the basis of the Central List of OBCs (Government of India) notified by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment on the recommendations of the National Commission for Backward Classes (available at the website http://ncbc.nic.in/backward_classes/index.html).

The certificate must mention non-creamy layer status of the candidate (non-creamy layer status issued by an authority mentioned in DoPT Office Memorandum no. 36012/22/93- Estt. (SCT) dated 15.11.1993).

The OBC candidates who belong to the 'Non-Creamy Layer' and whose caste appears in the Central List of the OBCs only, shall be eligible to be considered for admission under the OBC category (Validity period of OBC certificate in respect of 'non-creamy layer' status of the Candidates as per DoPT Office Memorandum No. 36036/2/2013-Estt. (Res- I) dated 31st March 2016). The Non-Creamy Layer (NCL) certificate should be issued after 31st March, 2026.

Certificate issued by authorized officials before the above-mentioned date/FY shall not be entertained.

It is a statutory obligation on the part of Departments/Centres to fill all the seats reserved for OBC NCL candidates.

RESERVATION POLICY FOR ECONOMICALLY WEAKER SECTIONS (EWS)

For the reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) Category, the University Departments/Centres/Colleges have reserved 10% seats for admission of candidates belonging to EWS category. The EWS certificate should be issued after 31st March, 2026.

Certificate issued by authorized officials before the above-mentioned date/FY shall not be entertained.

Reservation in admission is followed as per the guidelines of 'The Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act 2006 and 'The Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act 2012, published in the extraordinary issue of Gazette of India, on June 20, 2012 and OM No. 36035/02/2017- Esstt (Res) date 15th January, 2018.

Reservation for applicants, Persons with Benchmark Disability {Differently Abled (V.I. / O.H. / H.I.)}

- (i) As per Govt. of India norms, FIVE percent (5%) Horizontal Reservation is provided for Differently Abled applicants. For availing this reservation, such applicants need to produce medical certificate from the authorized medical officer. Such Applicants will get the horizontal entry in the respective category seats, if applicable.
- (ii) As per the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 Special care must be taken that the certificate bears the photograph of the applicant and the disability percentage should not be less than 40 %.
- (iii) In case of non-production of certificate, as per the above-mentioned parameters, on the date of counseling, the applicant shall be treated as any other regular applicant and the next applicant in the merit list, with valid certificate, shall be considered for admission in the category.
- (iv) Any request for extension of date for providing the PH certificate shall NOT be entertained under any circumstance.

It may be noted that the erstwhile Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protect of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 (No. 1 of 1996), under which reservation for Persons with Disabilities in admissions was provided earlier has now been repealed.

For the format of PwBD certificate, refer to Admission website www.admission.uod.ac.in. Disability Certificates issued after 01.06.2021 must be as per the Gazette Notification no. 1736 (E) dated 05.05.2021 issued by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities and applied through UDID portal.

However, Disability Certificates issued before 01.06.2021, will be considered as per other existing applicable rules and notifications of the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities.

Person with benchmark disabilities falling within any of the following specified categories of disabilities as mentioned in the Schedule to the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016

[2016 See Clause (zc) of Section 2 of the said Act] are eligible to get the benefit of the said reservation.

Concessional/waiver of fees in respect of PwBD

- a) Candidates with physical disabilities pursuing various programmes of study in the Faculties, Departments/ Centres of the University shall be exempted from payment of fees, paying Admission/Semester Fees including examination fee and other University fees, except subscription towards Tripura University Alumni Fund and Identity Card fee.
- b) PwBD Candidates who meet the merit for the unreserved category and will take admission in the Unreserved/ OBC-NCL/SC/ST/EWS category will pay the fee relevant for PwBD candidate.
- c) The students with physical disabilities residing in different Hostels of the University are exempted from payment of all hostel fees and charges except refundable caution fee and the mess fees.
- d) Candidates must ensure that the PwBD certificate is in the name of the candidate and issued by a recognized Government Hospital, bearing duly attested photograph of the candidate.

CERTIFICATE FORMAT

Candidates who belong to EWS/OBC-NCL category have to upload a valid certificate for claiming the reservation in the GOI prescribed format issued on or after 31st March 2026 on the day of application. Certificate issued ONLY by authorized officials shall be valid. The SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/EWS candidates should submit a certificate issued by any of the following authorities:

- District Magistrate
- Additional District Magistrate
- Collector
- Deputy Commissioner
- Additional Deputy Commissioner
- 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate
- Sub-Divisional Magistrate
- Taluka Magistrate
- Executive Magistrate
- Extra Assistant Commissioner (not below the rank of 1st class Stipendiary Magistrate)
- Chief Presidency Magistrate
- Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate
- Presidency Magistrate
- Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar
- Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and/or his/her family normally resides

ADMISSION TO SUPERNUMERARY SEATS

The seats are in addition to the usual number of seats declared in prospectus. Programmes in which the seats are distributed, the allocation of Supernumerary seats will be done in the departments only.

Following supernumerary seats are offered by Tripura University for admissions to UG, IMD and Post Graduate Programme:

- ❖ **Foreign Nationals**
- ❖ **Rank Holders**
- ❖ **Sports Quota**

Registration/Admission of Foreign Nationals

15% seats over and above (supernumerary) the seats sanctioned in each course shall be reserved for Foreign Nationals.

All candidates holding a foreign passport including those who have completed their previous qualifying degree from an Indian University/Board will be treated as Foreign Candidates for the purpose of their Registration/Admission in various Departments/ Centres of the University and they will be considered for admission under the quota prescribed for the foreign students. The Foreign Candidates seeking admission need to apply through Foreign Students' Registry Portal of Tripura University. No Foreign student will be admitted directly by the Department / Centres.

The foreign nationals are exempted from appearing in CUET (UG/PG) -2026. Admission in foreign students' category shall be done on the basis of Merit.

All the foreign candidates come under the same category of 15% admission quota for foreign nationals. This shall include foreign nationals with qualification from an Indian Board / University as well as from any Foreign Board / University.

An international student has to submit at least two letters of recommendation from the School/ College that he/she attended last.

For foreign nationals from SAARC countries, the Fee structure is like that for the Indian Applicants.

International students must register themselves with the Foreigner's Registration Office (FRO) after arrival in India. The FRO shall register International students and issue them a residential permit which is normally valid for a period of one year and should be renewed 15 days before its expiry date.

The documents needed at the time of registration in FRO office are:

- (i) A provisional eligibility letter issued by University.
- (ii) Passport with an endorsed student Visa.
- (iii) Passport sized photograph.
- (iv) Bonafide Certificate & Residential Proof.
- (v) Obtained Immunisation Certificate from any recognized hospital on arrival.
- (vi) Tripura University shall not pay any kind of Scholarship to the International students.

Registration/Admission of Rank Holders

The students of Tripura Board of Secondary Examination who have been ranked up to tenth in H.S. (10+2 stage) examination/ICSE/CBSE/state rank holders shall be eligible for admission in BBA/IMD/B. Voc. programs. No entrance test shall be required for such candidates. Their seats shall be treated as supernumerary.

The students at Tripura University who have ranked up to position three in their degree program for admission into concerned PG subjects and PG Diploma programs. No entrance test shall be required for such candidates. Their seats shall be treated as supernumerary.

Two seats have been reserved (supernumerary) for each department for the students of other universities who have ranked in their university in degree program. Such students need not appear for the CUET- 2026.

Registration/Admission under Sports Quota

The reservation under Sports Quota is meant only for those candidates who actively participate in the sports at the University, State, National, and international level Sports activities recognized by Ministry of Youth Affairs.

The five percent (5%) (supernumerary) of total intake in each programme (UG, IMD & PG) shall be filled by the candidates belonging to the sports quota.

Only the medal winner of National level games and sports can apply subject to production of requisite documents and verification by Tripura University.

Sports Certificate of Invitational/Memorial/Open/Prize Money League/Ranking

Competitions will not be considered.

Merit/Participation Sports Certificate of preceding three years, i.e., from 1st July 2023 to 30th June 2026 will only be considered for the current academic session.

Applicants are required to upload self-attested copies of Merit/Participation Sports Certificates.

Anti-Ragging Affidavits format (For all Student)

According to the UGC guidelines and orders of the Supreme Court of India, every applicant who is admitted to any course of the University needs to submit online ANTI RAGGING UNDERTAKING BY STUDENTS AND PARENTS/GUARDIANS through the UGC portal (https://www.antiragging.in/Site/Affidavits_registration_form.aspx).

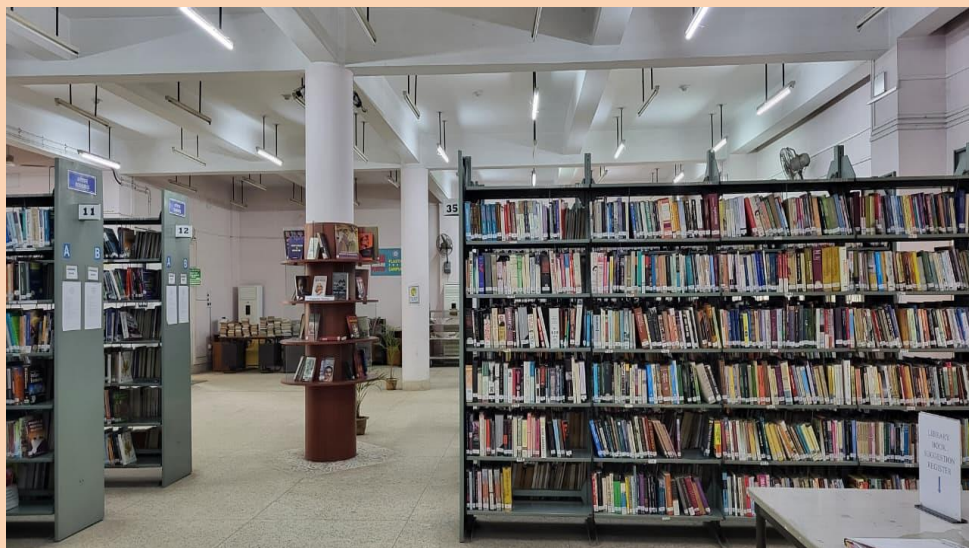

Central Library

The Central Library is constructed in three floors with the total space size 5415 sq.mts. At present, it is utilizing 2715 sq.mts for its regular operations. Total seating capacity of the library is 250. The library has well equipped Online and Audio Video browsing Center in



the first floor where people can access the internet and library-subscribed online resources. The Central Library of Tripura University has a rich and diverse collection that supports academic and Research needs. The library has well-qualified staff which includes Library Professionals, Information Scientist and office staff. The Central Library provides access not only to text and wide range of information to widen the horizons of the users' knowledge and to support a host of their learning activities.

The library has special collections on Tripura and North-East culture. It also has good collections on few eminent personalities like Swami Vivekananda, Rabindranath Tagore, Subhas Chandra Bose and Sardar Vallabhbai Patel. The whole building is Wi-Fi enabled. The Central Library offers a Reference Service, Lending Service, Document Delivery Service, Reprographic Service, News Paper Clipping Service, and New Arrival Alert Service to its users.

Hostels

Fully computerized internet-enabled hostel facilities are provided to students from outside the state/country, remote parts of the region and economically backward classes. Presently, there are two hostels for women and gents with 60 and 110 seat capacities respectively. Two more hostel buildings having separate rooms and bathrooms with 50 seats capacity are available for research scholars. Common Rooms with various recreational facilities and reading rooms equipped with reading materials and magazines, newspapers, T.V. etc. are also available in both the hostels.



The hostel serves food to the boarders according to a prefixed menu determined by the boarders themselves. Tripura University provides separate hostel facilities for boys and girls students. All Students are eligible to apply for Hostel seats. However, the seats are limited. This is their home away from home and a place where we can see the “Union in Diversity” of India. Students from different parts of the country with different cultural and religious backgrounds are living in complete harmony. The hostel allotment is as per the “Rules and regulations for Tripura University Hostels- 2022 and following criteria is used for hostel allocation (girls and boys):

- a) Distance from permanent address to campus and economic Condition.
- b) Reservation policy for admission as per GoI rules: Other Backward Classes (OBC NCL) 2%, Scheduled Castes (SC) 17%, Scheduled Tribes (ST) 31% and Economically Weaker Section (EWS) 10% of the total sanctioned seats.
- c) Person with Benchmark Disability (PwBD) 05% (Horizontal).

Computer facilities

Tripura University takes pleasure in providing computing facilities to the students, scholars and faculty. There are 5 general computer centers and 9 departmental computer centers with approximately 400 desktop computers. Computer centers are accessible to the students, research scholars and faculty during the University working hours for optimal utilization. For better access internet facility is available in all departments, centers, offices, hostels and staff quarters 24x7. Wi-Fi facility has also been made available for mobile phones and laptops in the central library, Guest house and all the departments. To work at times of power-cut, high-capacity

central UPSs are installed in most of the departments and offices for providing back-up during power failures.

Banking

The university has dedicated banking facility within the campus provided by State Bank of India. The bank has an ATM in the bank. The bank provides some facilities like savings account, RD account, student loan facility.



Health Centre

The University has a Health Centre for the students, faculty members and nonteaching staff of the University. Tripura University has its own Health Centre with two full time doctors (Male and Female), two nurses, a medical laboratory attendant and a female attendant to serve students, teachers, employees, officers, guests and their family members. A separate building has been allotted for this purpose where some beds with saline and oxygen facilities are available. Further, the University possesses an Ambulance with basic facilities in case of emergency to transfer patients to nearby hospitals. For emergency services, there is a 24x7 ambulance facility available on the campus.



Security

The safety of the students within the campus is being taken care by the campus security agency. The security personnel are kept vigilant especially for any inconvenience to the student community.

Auditorium/ Open Air Theatre

A Centralized air-conditioned Auditorium with 700 seating capacity is functional in the University for organizing various academic activities.

Apart from this there are smaller auditorium and an open air theatre of less capacity for the use of Departments.



Post Office

The University caters adequately to the requirements of the students, scholars and faculty within the campus Post office during university hours.



Mess and Canteen Facility

The University has made Mess for students of the University at affordable rates. The canteen offers various food items at a moderate rate, ranging from heavy lunch to light snacks and beverages. Presently the canteen has been shifted to the 1st floor of the newly constructed parking building situated behind the Administrative Building. The canteen is fully air-conditioned, having a seating capacity of around 100 students at a time. The University canteen is open from 10 AM to 5 pm on all days except university holidays. There are also canteens in Academic Building XI and in the main Administrative Building.



NET Coaching Centre:

With its launch in 2006, this Centre targeted to increase social capital in higher education from among the disadvantaged groups such as SC, ST, OBC (Non-Creamy) and the Minority. In Tripura the percentage of NET qualified candidates was very poor from these groups. Having had counselling/coaching from this Centre a considerable number of candidates have been successful in clearing NET in various subjects and many of them are now teaching in different colleges and universities. The Centre has implemented UGC prescribed syllabus on various subjects from both science and humanities. As per the UGC notifications, courses were revised from time to time. In every session we offer over 3000+ Practice Questions with Solutions by Highly Experienced and NET Qualified Faculties. Result oriented study materials also provided covering PAPER I, II & III respectively.

SPORTS AND EXTRA – CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The systematically and regularly practice of sports activities contributes to eliminating or reducing some deficiencies related to the somatic profile at the functional level of the body, supporting motivation for moving, controlling emotions, stress reduction, planning and organizing the work and leisure time activities, development of relationships, intra-group communication, and socialization improvement.

Sports

The Sports Board of Tripura University came into existence in 2007. Every year various games & sports are conducted by Tripura University Sports Board. Annual Sports Day is organized in which various outdoor sports like football, volleyball, Kabaddi and cricket etc and Indoor game competitions such as Table Tennis, Carom and chess etc are held. Every year the sports board organizes Inter College Tournaments in various categories as football, cricket, volleyball, Judo, Table Tennis and athletics among the different affiliated colleges under Tripura University and participates in East Zone/ All India Inter University competitions with university contingent.



Sports facilities include Multi-purpose Ground, Football Ground, Badminton Court, Volleyball Court, Basketball Court, Open Gym



Outdoor Games: Football, Cricket, Badminton, Volleyball, Athletics, Field & Track Events, Kabaddi.

Indoor Games: Yoga, Table Tennis, Carrom, Chess



Extra-Curricular Activities

Internal Complaints Committee (ICC)

The Cell is dedicated to safeguarding the interests and welfare of students and staff belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Persons with Disabilities. It works towards ensuring equal opportunities, accessibility, implementation of reservation policies and support services.

Other Backward Caste Cell

The Other Backward Classes (OBC) Cell has been established to implement and monitor policies and welfare measures for students and staff belonging to OBC communities. The Cell ensures effective implementation of reservation policies and related guidelines issued by the Government of India, UGC, Government of Tripura and other competent authorities.

Equal Opportunity Cell

The Equal Opportunity Cell of the University aims to promote an inclusive, accessible and equitable educational environment for all students, especially those belonging to disadvantaged and underrepresented groups. The Cell works towards empowering students through guidance, support and equal access to academic, intellectual, social and cultural opportunities available on campus.

Through these welfare bodies and support mechanisms, Tripura University strives to foster a secure, inclusive and harmonious campus atmosphere that enables students to grow academically, socially and personally.

Bioinformatics Centre

With the financial support of DBT, New Delhi, Bioinformatics Centre was established in the year 2008 at Tripura University. As per sanction of DBT, New Delhi the basic objectives of the Centre were to develop knowledge and research on "Establishment of Bioinformatics

Infrastructure Facility". Since inception the Centre has been extending services for the promotion of Biology teaching through Bioinformatics (BTBI). Several Seminars, Workshops etc. has been organized by Bioinformatics Centre for the Researchers of the North-East. The Centre also provided training in the field of Bioinformatics to the Students, Research scholars and Teachers as well.

Biotech Hub

DBT Sponsored State Biotech Hub was inaugurated by the then Hon'ble Dr Harsh Vardhan, the Minister of Science and Technology and Earth Sciences, in September 2015. This Hub has been extending training program in different areas of Biotechnology. Hub organizes seminars, workshop etc. for the students, research scholars and teachers. Modern biological research techniques are taught to trainees with current age of science. DBT, Govt. of India awarded the Hub as "Advanced level state biotech Hub" in 2017.

ICT Supported Smart Classrooms

In every Department, some of the classrooms have been converted into state-of-the art ICT supported classrooms through which classes are conducted.

Feedback System

The University has put in place a robust feedback system, viz., Student Feedback; Faculty Feedback; and Industry Feedback. The students are encouraged to provide feedback in teaching-learning of the University. The feedback is taken into consideration in framing syllabus and to improve teaching-learning process as far as practicable.

Mentoring Facility

In day-to-day teaching, teacher plays a vital role as mentor and guides the students (mentee) in their academic and related activities to groom them as a good citizen. Students are mentored by faculties in the areas of Examination; Classroom Learning; Job Placement; Higher Studies & Research; and Personal Counseling.

Training & Placement Cell

The Tripura University Placement Cell was established on 27.10.2005. The Cell plays a vital role

and is gradually becoming a key cell of the University. The competition for employment is increasing every day, and the task of placement is becoming a challenging one. The Placement Cell ensures and takes care to provide the best arrangements and hospitality for the visiting company officials and facilitates campus recruitment drives. It is relevant to mention here that the alumni of Tripura University occupy top positions in business, industry, R&D and academics in India and abroad and serve as the brand ambassadors of the alma mater.

The Placement Cell performs the following activities round the year:

1. Organizing various development activities that help in personality grooming of the students and provide them platforms to express themselves and enhance their soft skills.
2. Arranging winter/summer training for students.
3. Offering coaching classes for entry into services (for TPSC, Banks, Railway and other competitive examinations) for SC/ST/PH/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) and minority students in collaboration with Equal Opportunity Cell, TU.
4. Inviting various organizations to campus recruitment.
5. Organizing different job-oriented training programs by the reputed organizations.

Tripura University Business Incubator

Tripura University has been funded by Ministry of MSME, Govt. of India for establishing an Incubation Centre in the year 2019. Two ideas got selected for incubation in the Tripura University Business Incubator.

Outreach Activity

The University in fulfilling its educational social responsibility by providing training and social service assistance to the adopted villages of Tripura University and the villages adjoining Tripura University Campus.

Student Induction Program

To acquaint the students with the academic and administrative functioning of the University, an Induction Program is organized every year at the beginning of the academic session. The Vice Chancellor and other senior faculty members of the University address the newly admitted students. The students are briefed about program structure, university facilities, policies and procedures regarding examination, attendance, discipline, etc.

Evaluation and grading process

The University follows continuous evaluation system in which students' performance in the academic activities are assessed through assignments, quizzes, minor projects, term paper, book review, etc. in addition to performance in End Semester Examinations. The grading system is based on the grade points leading to SGPA for semester and CGPA for the Programme.

Curriculum Development

The University follows Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). Emphasis is given towards experience-based learning through lab-based exercises, Tutorials, Field and industrial visits, dissertation & project work, internships etc. Every Department has a Board of Studies which meets in regular intervals to assess the course syllabus of the department and give suggestions to bring about changes in the syllabus wherever deems necessary.
